Re: Lunch Increase

Dear Parent/ Guardian:

As Burrillville's Director of Child's Nutrition, I would like to welcome you and your student back to the upcoming 2017-2018 school year. My staff and I are very excited about the opportunity to serve you again. Please review the important information below to learn more about this year's Youth Nutrition Program.

**As part of the National School Lunch Program Reauthorization, the USDA requires all school's districts to evaluate Paid lunch prices and align them with the free lunch Federal reimbursement. This resulted in Burrillville's paid meal price to increase by \$0.10.**

Breakfast is available at Elementary Schools for \$1.00 and the Middle and High School for \$1.25 and \$0.30 for reduced priced students. Lunch is available for \$2.60 at all Elementary Schools and \$2.85 for Middle and High School Students. Milk is available for \$0.75. The reduced lunch rate will remain at \$0.40 at all schools. Additionally, both Middle and High School students will have the option to purchase assorted healthy A La Carte items daily.

In Mid-August the Free and Reduced Lunch Application will be posted on the BSD website at: [www.bsd-ri.net](http://www.bsd-ri.net) if you wish to fill it out before the start of the school year, otherwise it will be sent home on the first day of school. Please complete and return your application by Friday, September 29, 2017, so that we can process it and continue your eligibility without interruption.

Our primary goal is to meet the nutritional needs of your child while at the same time offering food choices that are interesting and appetizing. Please keep an eye on the monthly menu for upcoming dates and times.
