In the case of a prescription medication, a licensed health care prescriber's written order shall be provided, if it is not already on file in the school. A student shall be prohibited from sharing, transferring, or in any way diverting his/her own medication(s) to any other person. No school teacher, school administrator, or school health personnel, or any other school Personnel shall be liable for civil damages which may result from acts or omissions which may constitute ordinary negligence when a student self-carries and/or self-administers his/her own medication(s) in accordance with these rules and regulations. This immunity does not apply to acts or omissions constituting gross negligence or willful or wanton conduct. (R16-21-SCHO 18.10.1; 18.10.2; 20.14.1,20.15)
